



Uniform Policy

DRESS CODE:

- Our school's Governing Council has determined that the wearing of clothing described in the following school policy is a requirement for all students.
- It is expected that all children will wear the Aldinga Primary School colours of maroon or bottle green tops and black pants or skirts.
- Our school's uniform policy aims to give students a sense of pride in their school. The wearing of the school colours is also a safety issue as it is easy to recognise Aldinga Beach B-7 School students in the yard, on excursions or when representing the school.

Listed below are some suggestions in accordance with our school dress code:

Trousers/cargo pants/leggings	Black.
Shorts/cargo shorts	Black, maroon or bottle green
Tracksuits	Black, maroon or bottle green (no slogans).
Polo Shirts	Maroon or bottle green (plain, no slogans).
Long Sleeve Shirts	Maroon or bottle green. <u>If wearing under polo shirts</u> , can wear black, maroon, bottle green or white.
Year 6/7 Polo Shirts	"Middle Years" Custom designed involving school colours.
T-Shirts/shirts	Maroon or bottle green (plain, no slogans).
Jumpers/Windcheaters	Maroon or bottle green (no slogans). NO football or representative jumpers.
Year 7 windcheater	Custom designed involving school colours.
Skirts/Skorts	Black.
Dresses	Maroon or Green checked dress or custom designed school dress.
Hat (to be worn Terms 1, 3, 4)	School bucket hat available from the finance office or bottle green or maroon broad-brimmed (without cord) hat or legionnaire style hat. Beanies are allowed to be worn during cold weather before school, after school, big lunch and little lunch.
Shoes	School style shoe, sandal or sneakers.

For safety reasons, children need to wear their hair tied back when in woodworking, kitchen or at teacher discretion.

Unacceptable clothing includes:

- Midriff tops and tank tops
- Ripped clothing (patches acceptable)
- Mini skirts and brief shorts
- Thongs, slippers and party shoes
- Makeup
- Artificial nails
- Necklaces, dangling earrings and chokers (unless for religious/special reasons after negotiation with Principals)
- Caps
- Blue jeans

Non-compliance with the school's dress code will result in the following action:

- Classroom teacher to contact parent/carer if repeated non-compliance.
- Families in financial hardship may be able to meet with a senior staff member if they are unable to support the Uniform Policy to discuss.
